


Link Instruments MSO-28 Vista (64bit) and Win7 (64bit) work around Installation


The MSO-28 uses the Silicon Laboratories USB chip. They have a driver package that is Vista64 and win7(64) certified. This workaround will use that driver for the MSO-28.





Connect the MSO-28 to your computer.






